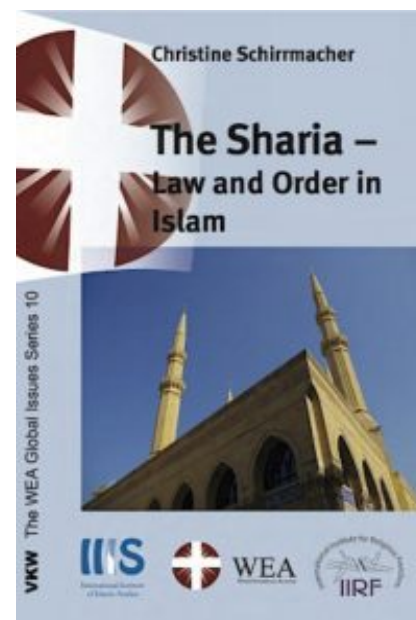


Law and Order in Islam
